


HIV IN ALASKA, 1985-1991

Through June 30, 1991, 386 of 29,807 (1.3%) individuals tested at the Section of Laboratories, Division of Public Health, were positive for HIV infection. Of 15,855 males tested, 340 (2.1%) were positive and of 13,781 females tested, 42 (0.3%) were positive for HIV infection. Of 5,503 Alaska Natives tested, 44 (0.8%) were positive for HIV infection.


Homosexual and Bisexual Males by Age Group
N=1314, N(unknown age)=1




All Individuals by Age Group and Sex
N=29807, N(positive)=386, N(unknown age or sex)=184




IV Drug Users by Age Group
